### ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited for admission to the BBA LL.B.(Hons) Programme of the **School of Indian Legal Thought, Mahatma Gandhi University, Suryakalady Hills, Nattasserry, S.H. Mount P.O., Kottayam – 686 006, Kerala.** for the Academic year 2024-25. The details of the Programme and eligibility conditions are as follows:

#### Selection Process:

Selection of students is based on the marks secured in the Entrance Test. The Entrance Test shall be of **1 hour 30 minutes** duration carrying 100 marks and is intended to test the General Knowledge, Logical Reasoning, Language skills, Legal Aptitude etc..of the candidates.

The applicants who have obtained 10<sup>th</sup>, +2 through Open Schooling System directly without having any basic qualifications are not eligible for admission to law programmes.

#### . 02. Documents to be attached to the application

- Original copies of documents to prove qualification/age/caste and other relevant certificates should be produced at the time of admission
- Those who have qualified from Boards (excluding CBSE, ICSE) outside Kerala State should produce eligibility/recognition certificate from this University, and those who have qualified from Boards (including CBSE, ICSE) should produce Migration Certificate from parent Board **at the time of admission.**

### **03. RESERVATION OF SEATS:**

Sufficient seats are reserved for differentially abled candidates and the remaining seats shall be considered for implementing mandatory reservation. Physically challenged candidates suffering from disability of 40% or more and certified as such by a Government Medical Board indicating the percentage of disability shall be considered for reservation.

### **COMMUNAL RESERVATION:**

The reservation will be given as per Government norms.

### **04. WEIGHTAGE OF MARKS**

Weightage of marks for proficiency in Sports/Games/NCC/NSS etc. and bonus marks for Ex-servicemen applicants and widows and children of Jawans/Ex-servicemen will be given as per the existing rules of admission.

### **05. GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- a. All those who possess the approved minimum qualification are eligible to apply.
- b. Only the Programmes and their equivalents approved by the Mahatma Gandhi University shall be reckoned as eligible qualification.
- c. No rounding of percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is permitted.

**If an applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she had indulged in ragging, admissions shall be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the educational institution.**

**The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed that if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the student concerned shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the institution.**

**06. (a) The Rules pertaining to the Programme BALLB(Hons) in SILT are coming under the purview of Bar Council of India (BCI), the regulatory Authority. All the candidates admitted to the programme is liable to comply BCI directives**

### **07. HOW TO APPLY:**

- a. Apply online through the link <http://cat.mgu.ac.in/BALLB>
- b. Candidates should remit the REGISTRATION FEE of **Rs.1200/-** through online payment of MGU.
- c. SC/ST candidates need to pay only **50%** of the registration fee.
- d. Fee once remitted shall not be refunded.
- e. The University will not be responsible for delay in online
- f. The filled up application form should be complete in all respects. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.

### **Special Instructions**

**1.1** For BBA LLB (Hons) and Integrated Programmes, weightage marks will be awarded to the Student Police Cadet applicant as per University order no.4999/ACA1/2021/M.G.U dated 25.09.2021. Applicants in this category should produce certificates of successful completion of Student Police training programme issued by the District Nodal Officer and District Police Chief together.

### **1.2 Reservation for Differently Abled Persons (PD):**

The students who seek admission in this category should submit their application(online) through CAT- MGU and qualify themselves in the Entrance Test. **5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created over and above in all exclusively for candidates with benchmark disability** (as per clause 32 (1) of chapter VI, The

Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016). **If candidates are not available in a particular category, the seats shall not be filled from any other categories.**

**1.3: Economically Weaker Section (EWS):** 10% of the total seats are reserved for applicants belonging to Economically Weaker section. For availing the benefit of reservation under this category as stipulated in GO (MS)No. 128/2020/H Edn dated 20/03/2020.

Applicants who wish to claim this reservation should submit their applications through CAT- MGU and qualify themselves in the Entrance Test. These candidates will also be considered for the general allotment if no seats are available in EWS Reservation category. For the same reason they should not submit separate application for the general allotment.**If eligible candidates for EWS Reservation are not available all such vacant seats shall be converted to Open Merit seats.**

**1.4 -Claim for Communal reservation under ‘Socially and Educationally backward Classes’ (SEBC):** Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O.(P) 208/66/Edn. dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time. Candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes as per G.O.(P) 02/2018/BCDD dated 08.03.2018 who belong to the non-creamy layer are eligible for reservation under this category. The non-creamy layer certificate should have been issued not earlier than 12 months prior to the submission of application. Only the claims of the candidates of those communities that are included in the list of communities appended in the prospectus will be considered.If eligible candidates for SEBC Reservation are not available all such vacant seats shall be converted to Open Merit seats

**1.5 - Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Quota:**

Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes Quota should obtain caste/community certificate from the Tahsildar.

**1.6 - Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates:**

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates who claim allotment to the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota should furnish community and income certificates obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Those OEC candidates whose annual family income is upto Rs. 8lakhs alone are eligible for such seats.

**1.7 - OTHER GENERAL RULES FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION :**

a) The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will be diverted to ST candidates and vice versa. If the seats reserved for SC/ST are remaining vacant such vacancies will be re-notified through print media. If SC/ST seats remain vacant even after the process noted above such seats will be filled up in the following manner:

b) The unfilled SC/ST vacancies shall be filled from candidates belonging to OEC, and in their absence from candidates belonging to SEBC. If the seats still remain unfilled, the same will be given to open quota.

**1.8 -All the aforesaid information is general in nature and all reservation will be subjected to rules of the University in force at the time of admission. Communal & Other Reservation will be subject to satisfactory verification of required Certificates (in originals) produced at the time of GD /Interview /Counselling /Admission wherever applicable as directed by the university and will be governed by the rules of the university in force and as amended from time to time.**

Fee for the PG programme offered in the University Departments will be as per the university decision. The fee may change from time to time according to the decision of the University / Government. The respective orders of the fees structures of the various programmes have been published on the website.

**1.9 - Candidates belonging to SC/ST communities allotted against merit seats or against the seats reserved for them are exempted from payment of fee. Candidates belonging to OEC who are admitted against merit seats or against the un-availed seats of SC/ST are exempted from payment of fee (As per G.O.(Ms) No.14/2005/SCSTDD dated 5.4.2005 & G.O.(Ms) No.36/07/SCSTDD dated 03.07.2007). Candidates belonging to OEC admitted through SEBC reservation are also exempted from payment of fee. (As per G.O.(Ms) No.50/2006/SCSTDD dated 22.09.2006).**

**2.0- Claim for fee concession to OEC Candidates :** Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities (OEC) are exempted from payment of fee at the time of allotment to Post Graduate Courses under Government/Community quota irrespective of annual family income as per G.O.(Ms) No.36/07/SCSTDD dated

03.07.2007. They should provide Community Certificate from the Village Officer in order to avail this benefit.

**2.01 -All candidates including SC/ST/OEC candidates will have to pay the 'Caution Deposit' as per rules.**

The fee for a course allotted to the candidate should be paid in the prescribed method within the stipulated time.

**2.02 -The Department as per the Mandatory Reservation Rules stipulated by the Government and University prepare a Priority List/Selection List/Rank list according to the Roaster Register kept in the Department and thereby an interview as decided by the University/Department if necessary.**

**2.03-** Any other items not specifically covered in this Notification will be decided by the Mahatma Gandhi University and the decision shall be final.

**2.04-**Appearance of a candidate in the Entrance Examination, or inclusion of a candidate in the rank lists/priority List or allotment does not entitle him/her for admission to a Programme, unless the rules regarding eligibility for admission, as laid down in the Notification under various Clauses, are satisfied.

**2.05-** No Individual call letter/ communications will be sent by post. Candidates must visit the websites on a daily basis and keep themselves updated with the latest news/notification/instruction published therein and are required to adhere strictly to the instructions/directions given therein.

**2.06-This Notification is subject to modification / addition / deletion, as may be deemed necessary by the Mahatma Gandhi University from time to time.**

**2.07- All the admissions will be provisional in nature until the candidates submit the original certificates/ documents in proof of academic eligibility.**
